Since 1995, the EPA Brownfields Program has funded grants worth almost \$88.3 Million in Region 10. The grants awarded in Idaho since 1995 include: 9 Assessment, 4 Cleanup, 2 Revolving Loan Fund, and 16 Response Program Grants. Idaho communities and Tribes listed below were selected to receive \$2.7 Million in 2009 for a total of \$15.1 Million in Idaho Brownfields grant funding to date.

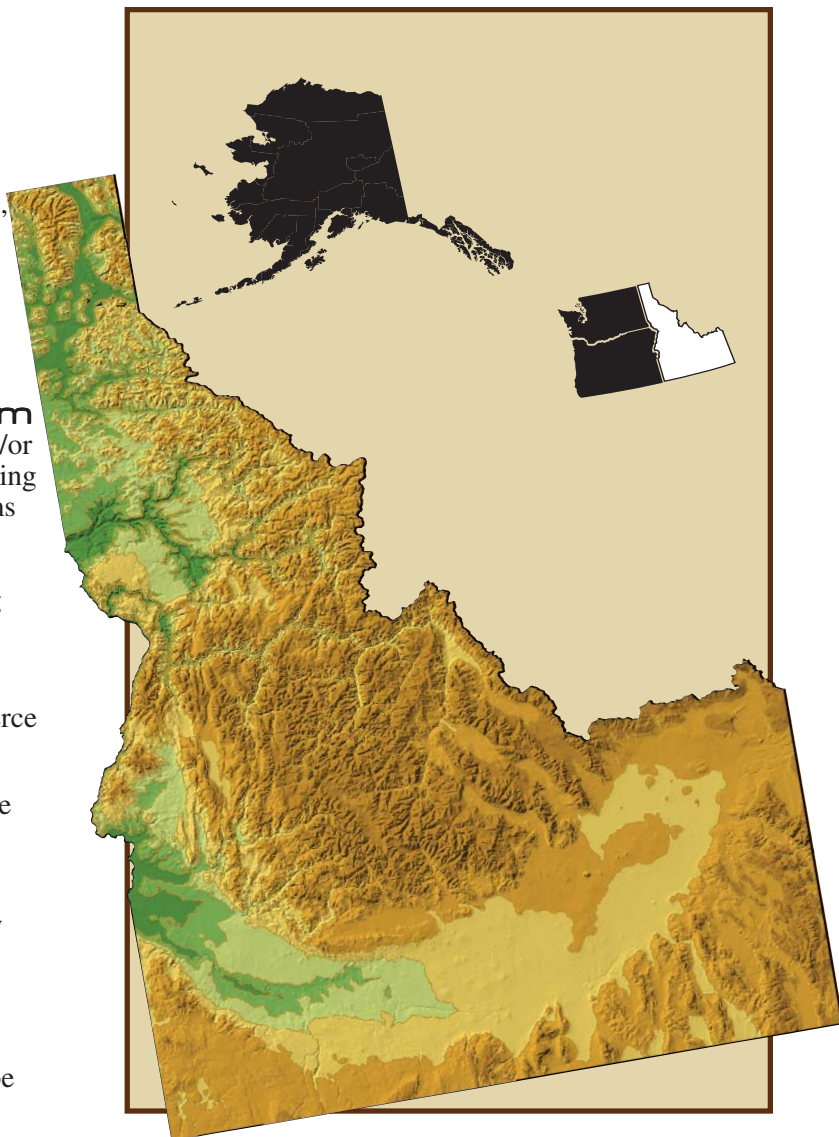

State & Tribal Response Program

- EPA provides funds to States and Tribes to develop and/or enhance their response program which includes supporting efforts to build capacity for Voluntary Cleanup Programs (VCP), develop a brownfields inventory and public record, and conduct site assessments. EPA has awarded \$4.6 Million to the State of Idaho since 2003, including \$855,000 in 2009.
- In 2009 two Tribes in Idaho received over \$638,000. They include the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes and Nez Perce Tribe.
- In 2009 the Idaho State Response Program provided site specific assessment assistance to 8 sites in the state and cleanup assistance to two sites.
- The state program has implemented the Community Reinvestment Pilot Initiative, which provides \$1.5 Million in state funding to be issued to property owners in the form of a Community Reinvestment Rebate equaling 70% of the qualified remediation costs incurred conducting the cleanup. The rebate can be up to \$150,000 per site.

Targeted Brownfields Assessments

- EPA has performed a total of 10 Targeted Brownfields Assessments (TBAs) on properties in the State of Idaho. A TBA is an EPA study that determines what type(s) of contamination are present at a site or do not exist at a site. A completed TBA can reduce uncertainty about site contamination.
